#1 Paola Longoria

Monterrey, Mexico Birthdate: July 20, 1989

A powerhouse in a small package, Longoria continues to solidify her place as one of the greatest female professional racquetball players of all time. She a 9-time U.S. Open Champion who earned more than 80 career Tour wins. She is setting records unbelievable for most sports including winning streaks of 36 consecutive tournaments and 152 consecutive matches.

On top of her outstanding racquetball accomplishments, she is a true sports star in Mexico. From magazine covers to TV shows, she is one of the most recognizable athletes in the country. Forbes Magazine named her, twice, one of the most powerful women in Mexico.

#2 Samantha Salas

Monterrey, Mexico Birthdate: December 15, 1986

A Tour veteran with seven Top 10 year-end finishes, "La Violenta," brings energy and an immensely powerful forehand swing to every match. She is one of few players to win over Longoria, and she did it twice.

Greenville 2018 was Samantha's first event back after having shoulder surgery in the summer of 2017. She came back strong working her way up to her highest pro ranking ever at #2. Off the court, Salas does Cross Fit to get ready for racquetball competition.

#3 Alexandra Herrera

Guadalajara, Jalisco, Mexico Birthdate: January 10, 1995

This hard-serving lefty has been quietly consistent as she has made her name known as a top tour regular. She is a rising young star in both singles and doubles and is half of the current Mexican Championship doubles team. She was a World Junior Champion in 2014 Herrera was a finalist at the first event last season in Atlanta and was a finalist in pro doubles at the 2015 US Open.



#4 Maria Jose Vargas

Buenos Aires, Argentina Birthdate: March 18, 1993

Vargas, who lives in Bolivia but represents Argentina, is an aggressive shot taker and a fun player to watch. Her highest pro rank was #2, that was right before she took time off to start a family. She has a beautiful little girl who will be 2 in August.


#5 Rhonda Rajsich

Phoenix, Arizona, USA Birthdate: October 10, 1078

A Tour veteran in her 19th season, Rajsich is a fan favorite who continues to amaze spectators with her athletic ability. She the all-time most accomplished American female racquetball player. She is a 4-time U.S. Open Champion and has finished #1 on Tour 4 times.

Prior to her start in professional racquetball, Rajsich had an opportunity to play professional basketball. You will frequently find her on a basketball court warming up for her racquetball matches.





#6 Nancy Enriquez

Chihuahua, Mexico Birthdate: October 18, 1986

Nancy played the pro tour years ago before taking a break to start a family. She has a son who competes in junior racquetball and a daughter who loves to dance. Last season was Nancy's first full season back to competing, and it was a successful one. She made a quick rise in the rankings and is now a regular top 10 player. She made it to her first final in Greenville in January 2018 and finished in the semis of the last event of the season in Kansas 2018.


#7 Natalia Mendez

Buenos Aires, Argentina Birthdate: January 28, 1997

Natalia, who is also from Bolivia but plays for Argentina, is a regular in the quarter finals and had 2 semi-final finishes last season. She has a unique forehand swing that can be deceptive and a challenge for her opponents. She pairs up with Maria Jose Vargas in doubles competition, also making regular trips to the quarter finals.

Guatamala City, Guatamala Birthdate: August 2, 2000



Riveros is from Bolivia but represents Colombia. She and Colombian player Amaya team up regularly, and successfully, in doubles. She is a regular top 10 player.

Riveros recently earned a racquetball scholarship to attend Colorado State University in Pueblo, Colorado. She hopes to travel on tour full time while in school.

Falls Park

Far more than a nature lover's paradise, Falls Park on the Reedy, located in downtown Greenville's Historic West End, is home to the iconic Liberty Bridge, and one of Greenville's greatest treasures.

Swamp Rabbit Trail

A 22-mile, multi-use (walking and bicycling) greenway that traverses along the Reedy River, this re-purposed old railroad corridor connects Travelers Rest with the City of Greenville, and offers many unique activities and destinations along the way.

Hampton Station

On the Swamp Rabbit Trail, enjoy food, drink, outdoor games, and the special services of cutting edge locally owned businesses.

The Village of West Greenville

A fun artist district where you will find a collection of over 65 businesses featuring galleries, service and design-based companies, retail stores, and wonderful restaurants.

Fluor Field at the West End

Greenville's 6,700-seat baseball stadium. A tribute to Fenway Park, Flour Field also captures a nostalgic look at the city with its reclaimed bricks from local mills. As is the tradition at Fenway Park, Neil Diamond's "Sweet Caroline" is sung in the middle of the eighth inning.

Bon Secours Wellness Arena
